'Crib Donations: This year, with the encouragement of Bishop Richard, this parish will be sending crib donations to Friends of the Holy Land. Every penny will help the poorest Christian families, especially in and around Bethlehem, the West Bank, Gaza and Israel, with education, employment, health or housing costs and initiatives. FHL is non-political and ecumenical. For further information, please take away the leaflet by the crib and keep our brothers and sisters in the Holy Land in your prayers at this time.'

Finally, I would ask you not only to pray for the people killed in France, but all who have recently died in all parts of the world from violence and conflict. In our own diocese we are mourning not only the death of two of our priests, Fr Martin Breen and Fr Robin Mountford, but also the organist Philip Stephen's from Rottingdean (funeral 10am 27 November in Our Lady's, Rottingdean) and 4 members of the Garvey Family from Woking parish who died in a plane crash at the weekend in Somerset.
