for many years. Pray for his widow Paddie and all his family. His funeral took place on Tuesday 19th September. May he rest in peace.

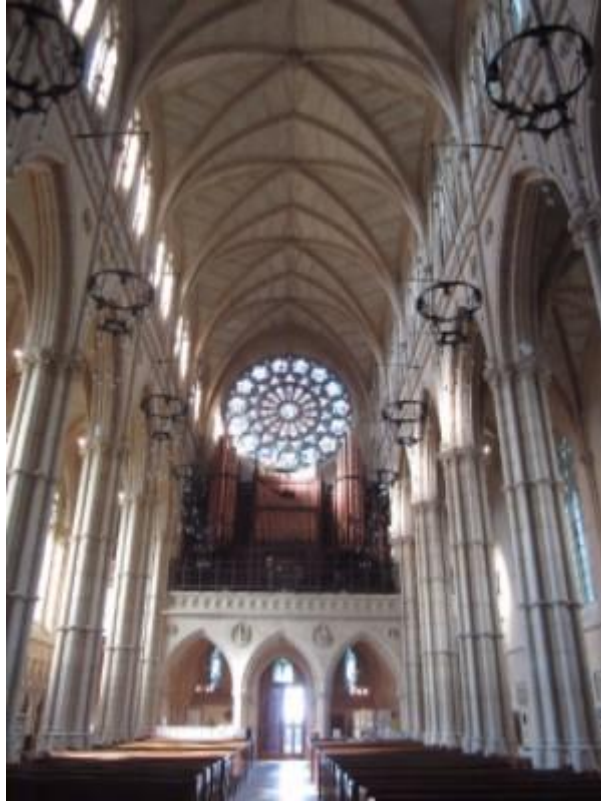
